B. For issuance of appropriate writ and give direction to after proper inquiry if Caste Certificate is found forged then dismiss the respondent no 6 from the service

C. For issuance of appropriate writ and give direction authorities to respondent recover salary and allowances which respondent no 6 has received certificates. by using forged.

D. For issuance of appropriate writ and give direction to respondents to lodged First Information Report under relevant sections.

AND/OR

G. For issuance of any other appropriate writ/s order/s, direction/s as may deemed fit and proper conscionable justice for doing to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the instant writ application may be disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to approach the appropriate forum for redressing the grievance as made in this writ application.
