Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with
N.D.P.S. (Khunti) P.S. Case No. 12 of 2026 corresponding to N.D.P.S.
Case No. 25 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 18(c), 29, 25 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation
against the petitioner is that the petitioner was involved in sale of
opium and 1.096 Kg of opium which comes under intermediate
quantity, was recovered from the i-20 car in which the petitioner and
the co-accused persons were travelling. It is next submitted that the
allegation against the petitioner is false. It is then submitted that there
is no FSL Report in the record to substantiate the allegation. It is also
submitted that though charge sheet has been submitted against the
petitioner but no witness has been examined as yet. It is further
submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 21.06.2026 as
mentioned in para-01 of the instant bail application. It is lastly
submitted that the petitioner undertakes to co-operate with the trial of
the case and also undertakes not to annoy or disturb the witnesses of

the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, N.D.P.S., Khunti in connection with N.D.P.S. (Khunti) P.S. Case No. 12 of 2026 corresponding to N.D.P.S. Case No. 25 of 2026 **with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
