“Learned counsel for the opposite parties submits that in the case of similar nature i.e “Gyan Prakash Sharan v. State of Jharkhand” corresponding to W.P.(S) No. 5187 of 2022 though the State has filed an appeal but the same is defective. She refers to the show-cause filed in Contempt Case (Civil) No. 103 of 2025 which is taken on record. She further submits that a discussion has been made with the State to comply the order passed in this case also, however, she contends that an appeal has also been filed in the instant case.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts, learned State counsel is directed to comply the order passed by the writ Court subject to final outcome of the Letters Patent Appeal.

List this case on 09.01.2026.”

Today, it has been informed that the appeal preferred by the State in “Gyan Prakash Sharan v. State of Jharkhand” [W.P.(S) No. 5187 of 2022] has been dismissed.

Accordingly, learned counsel for the opposite parties are directed to comply the order passed by the writ Court within a period of four weeks failing which appropriate order shall be passed.
