Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with S.T.
Case No.190 of 2026 arising out of Saraiyahat P.S. Case No. 67 of 2023
corresponding to G.R. Case No. 483 of 2026 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation
against the petitioner is that the petitioner committed dacoity and is
the habitual receiver of stolen property. It is next submitted that the
allegation against the petitioner is false. It is then submitted that
though the petitioner is not named in the FIR but without putting him
under T.I. Parade as mentioned in para-16 of the instant bail
application, charge sheet has been submitted against the petitioner. It
is further submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since
07.05.2026 after being remanded in this case as mentioned in para-23
of the instant bail application. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner
undertakes to co-operate with the trial of the case and also undertakes
not to annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner
during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner

be released on bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Sessions Judge-V, Dumka in connection with S.T. Case No.190 of 2026 arising out of Saraiyahat P.S. Case No. 67 of 2023 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 483 of 2026 **with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
