02/09.02.2026 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is facing three complaint cases arising under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and in another case the petitioner has been directed to deposit Rs.40,000/- and protection has been granted to the petitioner.

In view of his such submission, the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.40,000/- in the office of learned Registrar General of this Court by way of bank draft in the name of complainant/opposite party No.2 within two weeks and the same shall not be handed over to the opposite party No.2 without the leave of the Court.

- 4.** Issue notice upon the Opposite Party No.2 under registered cover with A/D as well as by ordinary process for which requisites etc. must be filed within a week.
- 5.** Office will proceed further as per the procedure.
