Heard Mr. Diwakar Jha, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Santosh Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the opposite party no.2.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the opposite party no.2, consequent to which, the entire compensation amount of Rs.1,88,000/- has been extended to the opposite party no.2.

Mr. Santosh Kumar, learned counsel for the opposite party no.2 has accepted the factum of compromise and has also submitted about the opposite party no.2 receiving the entire amount of Rs.1,88,000/-.

In view of the compromise, which has been effected and the same being an exceptional circumstance, this application stands allowed and the petitioner is exempted to surrender in connection with C. Case No. 194/2022.

I.A. stands disposed of.

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Since the opposite party no.2 has already appeared, no notice need be issued.
