1. Heard Mr Indrajit Sinha who appears with Mr Ankit Vishal for the petitioner and Mr Rahul Saboo, learned G.P.-II, with Mr Gaurang Jajodia for the respondents.
2. We issue Rule in this petition and expedite its hearing.
3. Mr Saboo states that counter affidavit will be filed within four weeks after serving an advance copy to the learned counsel for the petitioner. .
4. Rejoinder, if any, to be filed within two weeks of the receipt of the counter affidavit.
5. Mr Indrajit Sinha submits that in case the respondents, in their counter, agree for reimbursement either fully or partially, liberty may be granted to the petitioner to apply for a peremptory date for disposal of the petition. Further, he submits that this Court should clarify that the pendency of this petition should not preclude the respondents from deciding petitioner's representation at Annexure 11 dated 28.07.2026.

6. Accordingly, we clarify that pendency of this petition will not be a bar for the respondents to decide the petitioner's representation dated 28.07.2026. Further, if any decision is reached favouring the petitioner's contention either fully or partially, liberty is granted to the petitioner to apply for a peremptory date.
7. Mr Saboo waives service for all the respondents.
