2. Petitioner has been made accused in connection with S.T. No. 280 of 2025 arising out of Tisri P.S. Case No. 07 of 2025 for the offences registered under Sections 137(2), 61(2), 351(2), 140(1), 238, 61(3) of the B.N.S., 2023 and charge has been framed for the offences under Sections 103(1) / 3(5), 238/ 3(5), 61(2) of the B.N.S., 2023, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-IX, Giridih.

3. On 27.01.2025 at about 7.30 pm, the husband of the informant, namely, Vijay Yadav, was abducted by the petitioner and the named accused persons and subsequently, he was murdered.

4. It was submitted that the informant is not the eyewitness of the occurrence. It was further submitted that the name of the petitioner has come on the basis of suspicion.

5. Mr. Vijoy Kumar Sinha, learned A.P.P. appearing for the State after going through the case diary has submitted that there is no eyewitness to the occurrence and the name of the petitioner has come on the basis of suspicion.

6. In view of the submissions made above, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-IX, Giridih, in connection with S.T. No. 280 of 2025 arising out of Tisri P.S. Case No. 07 of 2025.
