Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Bano (Girda O.P.) P.S. Case No. 43 of 2025, corresponding to POCSO Case No.20 of 2025, for the offence under Sections 64, 62, 74, 76, 329 (4) and 75(1) of the B.N.S., 2023 and Sections 8/10 of the POCSO Act, pending in the court of learned Principal District Judge-cum-Special Judge (POCSO), Simdega.

On 29.06.2025 at about 1:30 a.m., the key of the motorcycle of the petitioner, which was taken by the brother of the informant, went missing. The victim called the petitioner and told him that the key has not been found. It is alleged that the petitioner came to the house of the victim and took her outside and attempted to rape her.

It was submitted that the entire case has been instituted because due to the fact that the brother of the victim had taken away the motorcycle of the petitioner, but he was not returning the key of the motorcycle.

Considering the nature of allegation, I am inclined to release the petitioner, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Principal District Judge-cum-Special Judge (POCSO), Simdega, in connection with Bano (Girda O.P.) P.S. Case No. 43 of 2025, corresponding to POCSO Case No.20 of 2025.
