The instant interlocutory application has been filed to condone the delay of 32 days' in filing of this criminal revision application.

It is submitted that the delay of 32 days has caused inadvertently without any mala fide intention on the part of the petitioner and there is no willful delay on the part of the petitioner and it is pointed out that the petitioner has no source of income and therefore for arrangement of money to move before this Court, the delay has taken place and the petitioner will suffer an irreparable loss if the delay is not condoned.

Having taken into consideration the aforesaid facts, the delay of 32 days' in filing of this criminal revision is condoned.

Accordingly, I.A. No. 9169 of 2022 gets disposed off.

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The petitioner is directed to take the steps impleading the proposed accused persons for sending summon as set out in para 12 of criminal revision petition namely Puran Mahto- as O.P. No. 2, Bhuneshwar Mahto as O.P. No. 3, Shankar Mahto as O.P. No. 4 and Harihar Mahto as O.P. No. 5 and Gopal Mahto as O.P. No. 6.

The petitioner is directed to take steps for issuance of notice to O.P. Nos.2, 3, 4 ,5 and 6 by both the process ordinary process as well as by registered cover with A/D for which requisites etc. must be filed within 3 weeks, failing which this criminal revision application shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.
