1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The applicant, who is in custody since 05.08.2024, has renewed his prayer for grant of bail in connection with S.T No.254 of 2024, arising out of Sisai P.S. Case No.87 of 2024, registered for the offence under Sections 103(1)/ 3(5) of the B.N.S, 2023, pending in the court of learned District & Additional Sessions Judge - III, Gumla.
3. From perusal of the record, it appears that earlier the prayer for bail of the applicant has been rejected vide order dated 11.02.2025, passed in B.A. No.10294 of 2024.
4. *It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that complete set of F.I.R along with its enclosures have been annexed with the present bail application and there is no suppression on his/ her part.*

Innocence of the applicant has been claimed and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that out of eleven charge-sheeted witness, ten have already been examined. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been renewed.

5. Learned A.P.P has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the fact that earlier the prayer for bail of the applicant has been rejected on merit, I am not inclined to reconsider the prayer for bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected once again.
7. However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial.
