This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that out of an amount of Rs.11,40,000/-, the petitioner has already deposited an amount of Rs.2,28,000/-. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a senior citizen and is suffering from various age-related ailments.

Learned Spl.P.P. has opposed the prayer for exemption made by the petitioner.

Only because the petitioner having deposited certain amount and the fact that no medical prescription in support of his ailments has been brought on record, this Court is not inclined to grant exemption to the petitioner to surrender and consequently, this application stands rejected.
