Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The instant bail application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of regular bail for the offences registered under Sections 27(b)(ii) of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Section 21(C), 22(C) of NDPS Act.

3. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner is languishing in jail since 04.08.2025. He further submits that as alleged that 1440 of WINSPOSMO Fort capsule was recovered from the possession of the petitioner and weight of one capsule is 0.57 mg hence total weight comes to $1440 \times 0.57 = 820.8$ mg = 0.820 gm which is small quantity and even then total number of capsules would be 33120 and weight would be $33120 \times 0.57 \text{mg} = 18878.4 = 18.8784 \text{gm}$ which is also intermediary quantity because commercial quantity of Tramadol is 250 gm and small quantity is 5 gm.

4. *Per Contra*, learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Considering the intermediary quantity, the Petitioner is enlarged on bail by furnishing bail bond of ₹ 20,000/- (INR Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Gumla, in connection with Gumla P.S. case No.239/2025

6. It is made clear that during trial the petitioner shall appear on each and every date before the learned trial court and he shall not threaten any witnesses and shall co-operate in trial. Further the petitioner will submit photocopy of his Aadhar Card and mobile number before the court below which he will always keep active and will not change and if any adverse report will come against this petitioner, learned trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail of this petitioner.
