

names of the legal heirs/successor of respondent No. 1 in course of the day.

7. Accordingly, IA No. 16796 of 2025 is disposed of.

8. Since the learned counsel appearing for the respondent No.1 has undertaken to file *Vakalatnama* on behalf of newly added legal heirs of respondent No. 1, there is no need to issue notice to the newly added legal heirs of respondent No. 1.

9. Learned counsel for the respondent No. 1 submits that this matter may kindly be taken up after two weeks to enable him to examine the IA meant for stay filed by the appellants.

10. Let this matter appear after three weeks under the heading for orders.

11. Learned counsel appearing for the appellants submits that the suit property is residential house and the execution case has been filed and that is at advanced stage, in view of his such submission, learned counsel appearing for the respondent No. 1 will take instruction in the IA meant for stay and file affidavit within three weeks.

12. Till the next date, there shall be stay of the execution case No. 1 of 2025 pending in the court of Learned Civil Judge, Senior Division-III, Ramgarh.

13. Let the said IA, meant for stay, be placed for further consideration on 20th April 2026.
