Heard the parties.

2. Petitioners have been made accused in connection with Jamtara Cyber Crime P.S. Case No. 55 of 2025 for the offences registered under sections 111(2)(b), 317(2), 317(5), 318(4), 319(2), 336(3), 338, 340(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and sections 66B, 66C and 66D of the I.T. Act and section 42(3) e of Telecommunication Act, 2023, pending in the court of learned Special Judge, Cyber Crime, Jamtara.

3. On 13.08.2025, Cyber Police, Jamtara on the basis of confidential information that cyber criminals have assembled in village Jasayadih, raided the place of occurrence and apprehended these petitioners along with co-accused persons. On search, mobile phones and e-gadgets were recovered from their possession.

4. It was submitted that no victim has turned up to claim that the mobile phones which were recovered from the possession of the petitioners, were used in cheating anybody.

5. In view of the submission made above, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) each, with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of
