15/24.01.2024 Though as per supplementary affidavit dated 29.09.2023 filed on behalf of the petitioners in W.P.(S) No. 3750 of 2022, the notices issued to all the private respondents, i.e. respondent nos. 7 to 43, have validly been served to them, yet Vakalatnama on behalf of the respondent nos. 7, 15, 20, 21, 24, 29, 33, 41 and 42 has not yet been filed.

2. Mr. Saurabh Shekhar, Advocate, submits that he has filed Vakalatnama on behalf of the respondent nos. 8 to 13, 14, 16 to 19, 22, 23, 26, 32, 39, 40 and 43.

3. Mr. Suman Ghosh, A.C. to Atanu Banerjee, Advocate, submits that he has filed Vakalatnama on behalf of the respondent nos. 25, 27, 28, 30, 31, 34, 35, 36, 37 and 38.

4. So far as W.P.(S) No. 4903 of 2022 is concerned, Mr. Raunak Sahay, learned A.C. to G.P.-V appearing on behalf of the State respondents, submits that the notices issued to the private respondents, i.e. the respondent nos. 7 and 8, have validly been served through the concerned department.

- 5.** However, no Vakalatnama has yet been filed on behalf of the said respondents.
- 6.** Mr. H.K. Mehta, Advocate, appears on behalf of the respondent nos. 44 to 46 in W.P.(S) No. 3750 of 2022 and respondent nos. 9 to 11 in W.P.(S) No. 4903 of 2022.
- 7.** Learned respective counsel appearing on behalf of the private respondents pray for and are allowed four weeks' time to file respective counter affidavits.
- 8.** Put up these cases under the heading "For Admission" on 21.03.2024.
