Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Hunterganj P.S. Case No.126 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 303(2), 62, 317(5), 3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner committed theft of the motorcycle and on the disclosure of the petitioner, one stolen motorcycle along with apparatus for breaking locks of motorcycles have been recovered. It is submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false. It is next submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as per the criminal antecedent report submitted by the Superintendent of Police, Chatra. It is next submitted that the charge sheet has already been submitted in this case. It is next submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he will co-operate with the trial of the case. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 31.07.2025 as is evident from para-14 of the instant bail application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned Addl.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M.-1st Class, Chatra in connection with

Hunterganj P.S. Case No.126 of 2025 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case.
