 learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
 Deoghar Town P.S Case No. 148/2025, registered the offences under
 section 126(2), 115(2), 351(4), 352, 81, 3(5) of the B.N.S 2023,
 pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Deoghar.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the
 petitioner and the informant was in relationship since last four years
 of filing the FIR. He also submits that now good sense has been
 prevailed between the parties and the compromise is reached
 between them and the marriage has been solemnized. In view that
 anticipatory bail may kindly be granted.

4. Learned counsel for the State submits that in the impugned
 order, it has come that the compromise has reached between the
 parties and the marriage has been solemnized.

5. Looking into the contents of the order of the learned Sessions
 Judge and in view of the submission of the learned counsel for the
 parties, it transpires the compromise has reached between the parties

and marriage has been solemnized between them. In view of compromise reached between the parties and the marriage has been solemnized between them, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner above named is directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from the date of receipt of the order and on the event of his surrender / arrest, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty-Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount of each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Deoghar, in connection with Deoghar Town P.S Case No. 148/2025, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

7. This Anticipatory Bail Application is accordingly allowed and disposed of.
