2. Petitioners have been made accused in connection with S.T. No. 392 of 2025 arising out of Topchanchi P.S. Case No. 50 of 2024 for the offences registered under Sections 341, 323, 307, 325, 326 & 506, 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-XI, Dhanbad.

3. On 20.03.2024 at about 09:00 am, petitioner along with co-accused persons had assaulted the informant and his family members, causing injury to several persons. It appears that son of the informant, namely, Ehtesham Ansari succumbed to his injuries.

4. It was submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation against the accused persons. It was further submitted that several similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court, as well as by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

5. Mr. Pratiush Lala, learned counsel appearing for the informant has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

6. In view of the submission made above, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) each, with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-XI, Dhanbad, in connection with S.T. No. 392 of 2025 arising out of Topchanchi P.S. Case No. 50 of 2024.
