 learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
 Topchanchi P.S Case No. 50 of 2024, registered under sections 341,
 323, 307, 325, 326, 506 and 34 and 302 of I.P.C, pending in the Court
 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that there
 are case and counter case between the parties and petitioner's side
 has firstly lodged the case and thereafter the informant's side has
 lodged the case. He further submits that the petitioner is not named
 in the FIR. He then submits that the name of the petitioner has come
 after one and half years. He also submits that the allegation of assault
 is there against Md. Mehmood, Md. Ashraf Ansari and Dildar Ali. He
 further submits that other co-accused have been granted anticipatory
 bail in ABA No.6284 of 2025 and in ABA No.3717 of 2024.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State submits that the injured
 has died and thereafter Section 302 of IPC has been added.

5. Considering that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and the

allegation of assault is there against Md. Mehmood, Md. Ashraf Ansari and Dildar Ali and the two co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail in aforesaid ABAs, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner above named is directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from the date of receipt of the order and on the event of his surrender / arrest, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty-Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount of each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad, in connection with Topchanchi P.S Case No. 50 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

6. This Anticipatory Bail Application is accordingly allowed and disposed of.
