

8. Mr. Suman Kumar, learned counsel, has stated that he has got no knowledge, what has been stated by Mr. Shewatang Tiwari, learned counsel.
9. The aforesaid fact has been confronted by Mr. Shewatang Tiwari, learned counsel by saying that whatever has been done as recorded hereinabove is on the basis of instruction of Mr. Suman Kumar, learned counsel.
10. Finally, Mr. Suman Kumar, learned counsel, has admitted the fact that he is representing the case of the litigant, the respondent herein in the criminal case pending in the Judgeship of Koderma and as such, he has ensured to communicate the service of notice upon the litigant concerned, who is being represented by him before the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Koderma.
11. Let fresh steps for service of notice be taken upon the respondent to be served through the learned counsel, who is representing the case of the litigant, the respondent herein, in the complaint case no.160 of 2017 pending before the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Koderma through ordinary process, for which, requisites etc. must be filed within a week.
12. Notice is made returnable on 16.06.2026.
13. The Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Koderma is directed to affect the notice through the learned counsel concerned and submit a report to that effect before the next date of hearing.
