2. The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Bashishthnagar P.S. Case No. 64 of 2024, for the offences registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 325, 302 of the I.P.C., pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chatra.

3. On 18.06.2025, at about 04:15 A.M., one Lakhan Singh Bhokta was murdered by co-accused Vijay Ganjhu. Some of the villagers have stated that the petitioner alongwith co-accused persons had assaulted the deceased.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that there is no eye witness to the occurrence and petitioner has been made accused only on suspicion. It was further submitted that similarly situated several co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court earlier.

5. Mr. Tarun Kumar, learned A.P.P., though has opposed the prayer for bail, but does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

6. In view of the submissions made above, I am inclined to release the petitioner, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chatra in connection with Bashishthnagar P.S. Case No. 64 of 2024.
