Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Ratu P.S. Case No. 44 of 2021, for the offences registered under Sections 326, 337, 338, 307, 302, 120B of the I.P.C. and Sections 25(1-A), 25(1-B)a, 25(6), 25(7), 26, 27, 35 of the Arms Act, pending in the court of Sri Manish Kumar Mishra, learned Judicial Magistrate, First Class-XXV, Ranchi.

On 12.02.2021 at about 5:15 P.M., the Revenue Deputy Inspector, Ratu Circle was shot by unknown persons, he died during the course of treatment.

It was submitted that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. It was further submitted that name of the petitioner has transpired in confession of co-accused persons. It was finally submitted that several similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court earlier.

In view of the submissions made above, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of Sri Manish Kumar Mishra, learned Judicial Magistrate, First Class-XXV, Ranchi, in connection with Ratu P.S. Case No. 44 of 2021.
