by the petitioner for condoning a delay of 59 days in filing
the revision application.

Having been satisfied with the reasons assigned
in the instant application, the same is allowed and the

I.A. No. 11219 of 2024

This application has been preferred by the
petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159
of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

The reason which has been assigned in the
instant application is of the petitioner having suffered an
accident and has limited mobility on account of his hip
joint having been fractured. In support of such contention
the prescription of a General Physician dated 20.07.2024
has been brought on record from which it appears that the
petitioner has been advised rest and there is no advice of
an X-ray or of to undergo a surgery despite there being a
fracture of the hip joint of the petitioner as stated by the
learned counsel for the petitioner.

In such circumstances, I am not inclined to grant exemption to the petitioner to surrender, and consequently, this application stands rejected.
