However, before passing any final order in the matter, it would be appropriate to give one more opportunity to the respondents to explain as to why the orders have not been complied with.

Let the respondent-District Education Officer, Deoghar and Secretary, Jharkhand Academic Council be physically present in the Court on the next date of hearing to explain as to why the orders passed by these matters have not been complied with.

Put up both matters on 15.07.2024.

It is made clear that if the order is fully complied and the salary shall be released to the petitioners, the physical appearance of the officers is not required.
