Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly admits that the order has been complied to a great extent, but the petitioner has not received salary/wages for the period from dismissal till the date of death.

2. After going through the show cause filed by the opposite parties, it appears that although certain benefits have been granted, no salary has been paid.

3. After going through the order, in respect of which the contempt petition has been filed for implementation, it appears that though the writ court has directed for all consequential benefits, but there is no mention of salary during the period when the petitioner was dismissed.

4. Accordingly, the instant contempt application stands disposed of with a liberty to the present petitioner who is wife of the erstwhile employee to approach for the salary for the period of dismissal till the period of death.
