Cr. Appeal (DB) (Filing) No. 24442 of 2025.

This appeal is directed against the order dated
04.07.2025 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Sahibganj
in B.P. No. 156/2025 in connection with Barharwa Rail P.S.
Case No. 12/2025, whereby and whereunder, the prayer for
bail of the appellant has been rejected.

It has been alleged that two persons were
apprehended at Barharwa Railway Station and from their
possession, counterfeit currency notes and other incriminating
articles were recovered.

It appears that so far as the present appellant is concerned, he has been implicated on the confessional statement of the apprehended accused. It further appears that there has been no recovery of any incriminating articles from the appellant. The appellant is in custody since 15.04.2025.

Regard being had to the manner of implication and period of custody undergone by the appellant, we while setting aside the order dated 04.07.2025 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Sahibganj in B.P. No. 156/2025 in connection with Barharwa Rail P.S. Case No. 12/2025 direct that the appellant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Railway, J.M.F.C, Sahibganj.

This appeal is **allowed**.
