**I.A No. 11534 of 2024**

I.A No. 11534 of 2024 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condoning the delay of 111 days in filing this instant Criminal Revision Application.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that due to financial crunch and also due to illness, the petitioner could not file this Criminal Revision within time and hence, the delay of 111 days in filing this instant Criminal Revision Application may be condoned.

3. Learned counsel for the O.P No. 2 raised objection and submitted that the delay has not been satisfactorily explained and hence, the delay of 111 days in filing this instant Criminal

Revision Application may not be condoned and this Interlocutory Application may be rejected.

4. Having heard learned counsel for both the sides and in view of the averments made in Paragraph nos. 5 to 12 of the I.A No. 11534 of 2024, the delay of 111 days in filing this instant Criminal Revision Application is, hereby, condoned.

5. Thus, I.A No. 11534 of 2024 is allowed and stands disposed of..

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner without prejudice to his case, is ready to deposit Rs. 50,000/- in the name of O.P No. 2 before the office of the learned Registrar General. It is submitted that the petitioner is also ready to settle the dispute of payment of Rs. 20,00,000/- (Rs. Twenty Lakh). It is further submitter that earlier the petitioner has deposited Rs. 76,000/- and above before the learned Appellate Court below and hence, he may be exempted from surrendering before the learned Court below vide I.A No. 11533 of 2024.

7. Learned counsel for the O.P No. 2 has opposed the prayer.

8. Put up this case on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025.

9. In the meantime, the petitioner will be at liberty to deposit the said demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- in the name of O.P No. 2

before the office of the learned Registrar General and shall file the affidavit/receipt concerned.

10. The Registrar General is directed to keep the said demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- in his safe custody and shall not be handed over to the O.P No. 2 till further order of this Court.

11. If the petitioner deposit Rs. 50,000/- in the name of O.P No. 2 before the office of the learned Registrar General, then no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner.

12. Let a copy of this order be sent to the learned Court below.
