Heard Mr. Karan Kaushik, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

The only ground which has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner is a tempo driver and he has a wife and five children to look after and being the only earning member of his family, he be exempted to surrender.

There does not appear to be a sufficient cause or exceptional circumstances to consider the prayer of the petitioner. Accordingly, this application stands rejected.

Consequently, the aforesaid I.A. is rejected.
