1. This matter has been listed before this Court as the same is defective.
2. This petition has not yet been registered by the Office, in view of the Standard Operating Procedure (S.O.P.) of the High Court as per which, the application will not be registered unless the same is defect free. Non-registration of the case means, it is not a pending litigation.
3. In view of the Standing Order No.9 of 2024 dated 09.07.2024 amended by Standing Order of 14 of 2024 dated 03.10.2024, once the defect is pointed out in an application, the same will not be registered and the matter will be listed before the Lawazima Bench where time will be granted by the Lawazima Bench to remove the defects.
