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06/09.09.2026 Heard Mr. A.K. Sahani, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Rajendra Krishna, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Sri Shubham Mayank, learned counsel for the opposite party.

2. Office has pointed out two defects i.e. defect No.25 and defect No.29.

3. So far as the defect No.29 is concerned, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he has filed supplementary affidavit showing cause of action and hence the defect No.29 is deemed to be removed and may be ignored.

4. So far as the defect No.25 is concerned, he has filed I.A. No. 5232 of 2026.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has pressed the interlocutory application being I.A. No. 5232 of 2026 which is filed for impleadment of parties in the light of office objection.

I.A. No.5232 of 2026

6. The instant interlocutory application being I.A. No. 5232 of 2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioners under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure for adding the defendants as parties who may be added as Performa Opposite Parties in the present memo of revision and which has been described in paragraph-5 and 6 of I.A. No. 5232 of 2026.

7. Learned counsel for the opposite party has raised objection in I.A. No. 5232 of 2026 and submitted that the petitioners are trying to delay the matter.

8. However, the learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that they are Performa Defendants and lis is only between the petitioners and plaintiff/opposite party.

9. Having heard the parties and going through the records, it appears that several parties in the plaint were the substituted plaintiffs and defendants in the Civil Suit arising out of O.S. No. 39 of 2021 filed before the learned Civil Judge, Sr. Div.XIX at Ranchi.

10. Accordingly, the prayer of petitioners is allowed and learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to implead those parties as mentioned in paragraph-5 and 6 of I.A. No. 5232 of 2026 in course of day by red ink and a copy of this Civil Revision be served to Mr. Om Prakash Tiwari, learned counsel for the State as well as Mr. Prashant Pallav, learned counsel for Union of India, who shall appear in this case.

11. Thus, I.A. No. 5232 of 2026 stands disposed of.

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12. Put up this case on 16.09.2026.
