Heard the learned counsel for the respective parties.

Having been satisfied with the reasons assigned in this application, the delay of 380 days which had occurred in filing this criminal revision application is condoned and this I.A. is allowed and disposed of.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of the Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

The submission which has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner seems to have been contradicted in the averments made in I.A. No. 14932 of 2025 in which it has been stated that the petitioner is a daily wager and is a very poor person. The contradictions emanating in both these interlocutory applications do not justify the prayer of the petitioner for exemption to surrender. Considering the same, this application stands rejected.
