7. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly admits before this Court that a chargesheet has been issued against the petitioner; however, no punishment order has been passed. Accordingly, in view of the aforesaid fact, this Court is not inclined to intervene in midst of the departmental proceeding and the petitioner is directed to co-operate with the departmental proceeding and the competent authority is at liberty to proceed in accordance with their own regulation and complete the departmental proceeding.

8. The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the final order of the departmental proceeding, if it is against him.

9. With the aforesaid observation, the instant writ application stands disposed of.
