Heard Mr. Nawal Kishor Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had to undergo cranial surgery on account of consistent headache he has been suffering. It has been submitted that the petitioner suffers from headache even now and he is not fully cured.

Learned A.P.P has opposed the prayer for exemption to surrender made by the petitioner.

In support of his contention, learned counsel has brought on record a prescription dated 18.12.2021 from which it appears that surgery was suggested by way of craniotomy but there is no further evidence on record as to whether the surgery had indeed been performed or not. Learned counsel for the petitioner is unaware about the said fact as he is not in a position to state as to whether the surgery has been carried out on the petitioner or not.

In view of the aforesaid therefore, I am not inclined to grant exemption to the petitioner to surrender and consequently I.A. No.3812 of 2026 stands rejected.
