Heard the learned counsel appearing for the respective parties.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Gawan PS Case No. 120/2021.

The son of the informant was suspected to have been abducted by unknown persons. Subsequently, the dead body of the son of the informant was recovered.

It appears that the petitioner has been implicated on the confession of co-accused Sandeep Kumar Mushar and as per para-68 of the case diary, the dead body of the son of the informant was recovered on the confession of Sandeep Kumar Mushar. The petitioner is in custody since 20.11.2021. Although the status report was called for from the learned trial Court but the said report dated 10.03.2026 neither reveals as to the number of witnesses, who have been examined nor does it say the number of witnesses, who are left to be examined or for that matter the tentative time the learned trial Court shall take in concluding the trial.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has been implicated on the confessional statement of Sandeep Kumar Mushar and there is no evidence other than the said confessional statement, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-III, Giridih in connection with Gawan PS Case No. 120/2021, corresponding to S.T. Case No. 353/2022, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall remain physically present before the learned trial Court on each and every date till the conclusion of the trial unless prevented by sufficient cause.
