06/ 17.04.2026 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that first ACP has already been granted to the petitioner and in the writ court order, direction has been issued to provide the similar benefit, as provided to the other similarly situated employees.

2. Now the question has been raised by the authorities concerned with regard to recognition of Mandar Vidyapith, Upadhyay, Bhagalpur.

3. It is an admitted position that first ACP has already been provided to the petitioner and further similarly situated other employees have also been provided the second ACP and Annexure-D of the show cause, *prima facie* suggests that the other persons have already been provided the same benefits.

4. In that view of the matter, O.P. No. 2 is hereby directed to file the supplementary show cause, disclosing therein why the petitioner has been deprived in spite of the writ court order and he will do so within two weeks.

5. Let this matter appear after two weeks on the assigned day.
