as learned counsel appearing for the State.

**2.** The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with  
Argora P.S. Case No.116 of 2023, for the alleged offences registered  
under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 325, 326, 307, 354,  
448 and 504 of Indian Penal Code pending in the Court of learned  
JMFC at Ranchi.

**3.** Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that  
the scuffle took place between the parties due to dispute of parking  
vehicle. She further submits that there are case and counter case  
between the parties and nothing has been stated about the injury.  
She then submits that in identical situation co-accused persons have  
already been granted anticipatory bail in A.B.A. No.5272 of 2024  
and 5274 of 2024.

**4.** Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the allegations are there of assault.

**5.** Considering that the altercation took place due to dispute relating to parking space and there are case and counter case between the parties and in identical situation co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail in the aforesaid A.B.As., I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

**6.** Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned JMFC at Ranchi in connection with Argora P.S. Case No.116 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
