Heard the learned counsel appearing for the respective parties.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 13 of 2025.

It has been alleged that the petitioner and others were apprehended by the police and from the possession of the petitioner, 103 grams of brown sugar was recovered.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the recovered quantity of brown sugar is an intermediary quantity. It has further been submitted that some of the co-accused persons have been granted bail in B.A. No. 10648 of 2025 and B.A. No. 10521 of 2025. Learned counsel adds that the petitioner is in custody since 01.10.2025.

Learned Spl.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Godda in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 13 of 2025, arising out of Godda (Town) P.S. Case No. 196 of 2025.
