1. Heard Mr. Sudhansu Kumar Deo, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Spl.P.P.
2. This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.
3. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is suffering from enlarged prostate as well as Umbilical hernia and other diseases, in support of which various medical prescriptions have been brought on record.
4. It has also been submitted that the petitioner is aged about 62 years.
5. Learned Spl.P.P. has opposed the prayer made in this application.
