2. The only grievance of the petitioner is that the direction given by Sub-Divisional Officer, Jamtara to the Circle Officer, Nala vide Letter No. D.B. No.537 dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure-6 to this writ petition) has not been complied.

3. Learned counsel for the State submits that if matter is still pending, the direction will be complied with and an appropriate report will be forwarded to the concerned officer.

4. Considering the said submission, I direct the respondent No.4- Circle Officer, Nala to immediately comply the direction as contained in Annexure-6 and communicate the order to the concerned Officer within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
