Heard the learned counsel for the respective sides.

In this writ application, the petitioner has prayed for a direction upon the respondents to register an FIR and to take action against the erring police officers for illegal detention, custodial torture, kidnapping and criminal intimidation of the petitioner. The petitioner has further prayed for a direction upon the Superintendent of Police, Deoghar and Pakur for initiating a departmental action against the erring officers as well as to pay interim compensation to the petitioner for violation of his fundamental rights.

Though a counter-affidavit has been filed and it seems that a preliminary inquiry had been conducted but considering the prayer made in this application for registration of an FIR based on the complaint made by him, the petitioner can very well approach the concerned forum for redressal of his grievance, in view of the judgment in the case of *"Sakiri Vasu v. State of U.P. and Ors., reported in (2008) 2 SCC 409*. This application consequently stands disposed of.
