1. Heard Mr. Din Dayal Saha, learned counsel for the appellant and learned A.P.P.
2. This appeal is directed against the order dated 26.11.2025 passed in A.B.P. No.483 of 2025 by learned Sessions Judge, Pakur arising out of Pakur Town P.S. (Malpahari O.P.) Case No.182 of 2025, whereby and whereunder the prayer for anticipatory bail of the appellant has been rejected.
3. It has been alleged that on a secret information, a raid was conducted by the police and two persons on a motorcycle had managed to flee away and on search of the motorcycle, some sacks were found which contained gelatins and 1148 pieces of gelatin sticks were recovered and seized.
4. Submission has been advanced by learned counsel for the appellant that the appellant has been implicated only on the basis of suspicion. It has further been submitted that the appellant is an employee of Ghudha Sk., who has an existing explosive license.
5. Learned A.P.P. has submitted that the appellant has been implicated on the basis of a secret information.
6. Regard being had to the manner of implication of the appellant, we while setting aside the order dated 26.11.2025 passed in

A.B.P. No.483 of 2025 by learned Sessions Judge, Pakur arising out of Pakur Town P.S. (Malpahari O.P.) Case No.182 of 2025, direct the appellant to surrender before the learned Trial Court within a period of four weeks and on his surrender, the learned Court below shall release him on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of Learned S.D.J.M., Pakur in connection with Pakur Town P.S. (Malpahari O.P.) Case No.182 of 2025.

7. Accordingly, this appeal is allowed.
