02/ 16.03.2026: The petitioner claims his benefit of 1st and 2nd ACPs as it is the case of the petitioner that during his entire service period, he has not been granted any regular promotion.

2. Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that if the petitioner files a fresh representation before the respondent No.-2 Deputy Commissioner, Deoghar, his case will be considered and an appropriate order will be passed and if it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the relief, the same will be granted to the petitioner.

3. Considering the aforesaid submission, I direct the petitioner to file a fresh representation annexing all the documents, before the respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Deoghar within four weeks.

4. On receipt of such representation, the respondent No.2 will consider the representation of the petitioner and pass a reasoned order within six weeks.

5. If the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same should be extended to him within two weeks thereafter.

6. If any part of the claim/ representation is rejected for any reason, a detailed speaking order should be communicated to the petitioner.

7. With the aforesaid directions, this writ petition stands **disposed of**.
