This interlocutory application has been preferred by the petitioner for payment of salary of the petitioner which is due from October 2022 till date.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only on the basis of internal politics he has been debarred from the legitimate salary, as a matter of fact respondent nos. 7 and 8 are the instrumental in disturbing the petitioner in his work by threatening him of removal from his post of head maulvi.

3. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is still working; as such at least during pendency of this writ application the legitimate salary be paid to this petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the petitioner has been terminated from service. However, he did not dispute that the petitioner will not be entitled for legitimate salary after calculation.

5. Having regard to the aforesaid submission and looking to the averments made in this interlocutory application, I.A. No. 4076 of 2024 is allowed. The concerned respondent is directed to calculate the amount which is admissible to be paid to the petitioner. It goes without saying that the amount shall be paid before the next date of hearing.

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6. Issue notice upon the respondent nos. 7 and 8 under registered cover with A/D as well as ordinary process for which requisites etc. must be filed within ten days, failing which the instant application will stand rejected without further reference to a Bench.
