06/22.02.2024 The present interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner for impleading Wasim Jahan Khan as respondent no. 7 in the present writ petition, whose name appears as husband of the deceased employee – Maya Devi (the mother of the petitioner) in her death certificate.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after death of her mother, who was an employee of the respondent-CCL, the petitioner made an application seeking compassionate appointment. However, another application seeking compassionate appointment was filed by Wasim Jahan Khan claiming himself to the husband of the deceased employee – Maya Devi. It was claimed that his name found mention as husband of Late Maya Devi in her death certificate. Under the said circumstance, Wasim Jahan Khan, whose description has been given in paragraph no. 5 of the present interlocutory application, may be permitted to be impleaded as respondent no. 7 in the present writ petition.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and for the reasons stated in the present interlocutory application, let Wasim Jahan Khan, whose description has been given in paragraph

no. 5 of the present interlocutory application, is permitted to be impleaded as respondent no. 7 in the present writ petition.

4. The present interlocutory application stands disposed of.

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5. Let necessary insertion in the cause title of the writ petition be made by learned counsel for the petitioner in course of the day.

6. Issue notice to the newly impleaded respondent no. 7 under registered cover with A/D as well as by ordinary process for which requisites etc. must be filed within one week.

7. Put up this case under appropriate heading on 18.04.2024.
