1. Order dated 25.04.2025 reads as follows:

“The stand of the opposite parties is that the similar issue pending before the Hon’ble Apex Court has already been dismissed as indicated in Contempt Case (Civil) No. 922 of 2022.

Accordingly, the opposite parties are directed to file the compliance report in true letter and spirit before the next date of hearing, failing which opposite party no.2 shall appear in person and explain as to why a proceeding for contempt be not initiated against him in the factual background that the State has lost its case before the Hon’ble Apex Court.

List this case on 16.06.2025.”

2. From the aforesaid order, it is clear that the O.P.-State has lost the case up till Hon’ble Supreme Court; however, the order has not been complied. This is clear contempt of the Court’s order; accordingly, O.P. No.2 shall physically appear before this Court on 26.09.2025 in order to demonstrate as to why a proceeding for contempt be not initiated against him for deliberately not complying the order of the Writ Court and making several hindrances.

3. It goes without saying that earlier also this opposite party had prayed for extension of time for compliance of the order.

This clearly goes to show the intention of the officer to make hindrance in the compliance of the Court's order.

5. It goes without saying that if the order will be complied in true letter and spirit, the personal appearance shall be dispensed with.
