1. Reference may be made to the order dated 23rd April, 2024,
which reads as under:-

*"Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
L.P.A No. 259 of 2023 preferred by the State of
Jharkhand against the order dated 08.08.2022 passed in
W.P.(S) No. 2406 of 2017 has already been dismissed by
learned Division Bench on 23.02.2024. Despite the said
fact, the aforesaid order of this Court has not been
complied.*

*Md. Asghar, AC to Sr. SC-II appearing on behalf
of the opposite party nos. 2 to 5, prays for and is allowed
time till 14.05.2024 by way of last indulgence to file the
compliance affidavit, failing which appropriate order
against the concerned opposite party will be passed on
the next date fixed.*

*Put up this case under the heading "For
Admission" on 13.06.2024."*

2. No compliance affidavit has been on behalf of the opposite
party nos.2 to 5.
3. Under the said circumstance, let notice be issued to the
opposite party nos.2 to 5 in Form-1 under Rule 393 of the High
Court of Jharkhand Rules, 2001 through ordinary process for
which requisites etc. must be filed within one week.
4. Put up this case under the same heading on 16th August, 2024.

5. If the aforesaid order is not complied before the said date, the opposite party nos.2 to 5 shall remain physically present before this Court.
