It has been informed by learned senior counsel for the petitioner that on the one hand, the order passed by the writ Court dated 08.06.2022 has not yet been complied with, and on the other hand, the State has lost its case before the Division Bench in LPA No. 659 of 2023.

Learned counsel for the opposite party submits that they are contemplating to file an SLP before the Hon'ble Apex Court. An interlocutory application has been filed being I.A. No. 14350 of 2025 for extension of time. However, admittedly, neither a stay order against the writ court's order has been produced, nor the SLP has been filed.

In the peculiar circumstances the concerned opposite party no.2 is directed to comply the order in true letter and spirit subject to the final outcome of any S.L.P., if filed within a period of four weeks, failing which, appropriate order shall be passed on the next date of hearing.
