09/13.10.2023 Mr. Yashvardhan, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that though a show cause affidavit has been filed on behalf of the opposite party no. 3 on 11.10.2023, however, perusal of the same would suggest that the said opposite party has not yet complied the order dated 08.06.2022 passed in W.P.(S) No. 2538 of 2017 in its true letter and spirit, as the claim for regularization of the petitioners' services has erroneously been rejected despite clear observation of the Court made in paragraph no. 6 of the said order.

Mr. Sachin Kumar, learned AAG-II assisted by Mr. Suresh Kumar, learned SC (L&C)-II appearing on behalf of the opposite parties, prays for eight weeks' more time to comply the order dated 08.06.2022 in its true letter and spirit and to file a compliance affidavit.
