“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that L.P.A. No.659 of 2023 preferred by the State of Jharkhand is still lying defective before Lawazima Board. The said fact suggests that the State of Jharkhand is not serious in pursuing the said L.P.A.

Learned AC to AAG-II appearing on behalf of the opposite parties prays for and is allowed four weeks more time by way of last indulgence to pursue the aforesaid L.P.A.

Put up this case under the same heading on 12th June, 2024.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the online status of L.P.A. No. 659/2023, it is evident that the same is still lying defective.
3. Learned counsel for the opposite party-State submits that almost all the defects in the said L.P.A have been removed and she is taking sincere steps to get the same listed for its consideration. She accordingly prays that the present case may be adjourned for three weeks.
4. Considering the aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the opposite party-State, let this case be listed on 12.07.2024 under the heading “For Admission”.

5. If the opposite party-State fails to pursue the aforesaid L.P.A within the period of three weeks, an appropriate order against the O.P. Nos. 2 & 3 will be passed on the next date.
